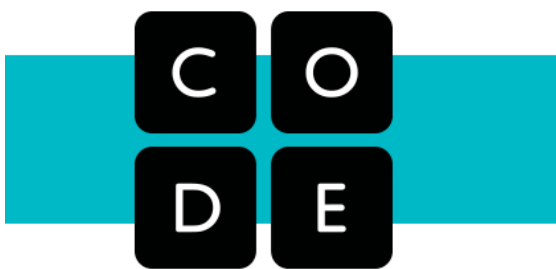

Learn how 'video games' are transformed into powerful learning strategies through "gamification", and how this might impact your classroom now, and in the future. We will work through different aspects of gamification to transform your classroom.
